2021 Missouri Legislature, §162.686, RSMo.

Parents may audio record any meeting held under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), the federal law governing special education, such as individualized educational planning meetings (IEP meetings). In addition, parents may record meetings under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504 meetings) which involve the accommodation of students with disabilities.

"Please notify Mexico Public Schools by contacting your child's case manager, counselor, or the office of the building where your child attends at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled meeting of your intent to record. Thank you in advance for your cooperation."
